AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Baljinder Singh has filed anticipatory bail in FIR No.196 dated 18.02.2023, under Sections 195-A, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Line Sirsa, District Sirsa.

2. Earlier vide order dated 27.02.2024 present petitioner was granted interim bail which runs as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the allegations levelled in the complaint are not made out against the petitioner as he never extended any kind of threats to the complainant and there is no occasion for doing so, particularly when the deposition of the complainant was already over.

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In the meantime, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing adequate bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Today learned counsel representing the State of Haryana submitted that as per *pairvi* report submitted by SI Ran Singh present petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any other purpose.

4. Therefore, the interim bail already granted to petitioner-Baljinder Singh vide order dated 27.02.2024 stands confirmed subject to the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petition is accordingly allowed.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
