1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of certiorari, quashing the orders Annexures P-8 and P-9 and a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent to grant additional pay of Rs.120/- per month to the petitioners in accordance with the Government sanction (Annexure P-1).
2. Mr. Gaurav Tangri, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent and filed his power of attorney in the Court which is taken on record. He submits that petitioner No.1 has unfortunately died on 08.08.2006 and even petitioner No.2 has also died.
3. Since the LR's of the petitioners have not been brought on record, therefore, the instant petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the LR's of the petitioners to revive the present petition in case any cause still survives.
