AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. The present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ directing the respondents to release all admissible benefits of pension scheme with arrears from the date of accrual till date of payment.
2. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner could not opt for Old Pension Scheme on account of the fact that the resolution was not given wide circulation. In this regard, a legal notice dated 06.11.2023, Annexure P-10, has been submitted by him, which has yet not evoked any response. He thus, at this stage, on instructions, submits that the petitioner is sanguine of it being considered in a positive manner, in case, a direction is given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner by granting him an opportunity of hearing.
3. Notice of motion.
4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. M.K. Dogra, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the limited prayer made.
5. In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of

the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the legal notice dated 06.11.2023, Annexure P-10 and decide the same within a period of 6 months and if found entitled, necessary benefits be granted to the petitioner forthwith. However, in the eventuality of the relief being denied, a speaking order be passed, after associating him therewith.
