NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned selection and appointment of respondents No.4 to 27 to the post of Telephone Operator/Gauge Reader and quashing of order dated 21.02.1997 (Annexure P-6) whereby, the claims of the petitioners have been rejected, further a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to make the appointment to the abovesaid posts amongst the persons, who have been working on those posts only and to accord the work-charged regular status to the petitioners.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions from petitioner No.9 and LR's of petitioner No.4, submits that they do not want to further pursue the present petition.

Learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 3 submits that as the relief claimed in the present petition has already been granted to the petitioners, the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
