KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has invoked criminal writ jurisdiction of this Court through the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for ensuring protection to the life and liberty and for issuance of mandamus upon the official respondents not to harass by calling the petitioner him again and again in the Police Station.
2. The learned State counsel, who is on advance notice informs this Court that the representation, which has been filed by the petitioner, has already been examined and the *Calandra* under Section 145 Cr.P.C. has already been initiated *qua* the property, which is the root cause of the dispute.
3. In view of the statement suffered by the learned State counsel, the instant petition is disposed of, however, with liberty to the petitioner to throw challenge, if so, advised to the *Calandra*, which has been initiated by the police official concerned.
