1. In the present petition, grievance of the petitioner is that he is entitled for the grant of benefit of 3rd ACP w.e.f. 01.10.2015, whereas the said benefit has been extended by the respondents from 01.07.2017 hence, the respondents are liable to be directed to grant the said benefit to the petitioner from 01.10.2015 with all consequential benefits along with arrears and interest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 11.01.2022 (Annexure P/7), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case the representation dated

11.01.2022 (Annexure P/7) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the respondents, the same will be decided by the respondents in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
