Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, in the present petition claim of the petitioner is for the grant of benefit of adhoc service towards the annual increment but the petitioner is not pressing the said claim and prays that respondents be directed to consider the adhoc service rendered by the petitioner as qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is made by the petitioner raising the said claim, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, the petitioner is found entitled for the said relief, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner as well.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view

the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate representation raising his claim for treating the adhoc service rendered by him as qualifying service for the purpose of computing his pensionary benefits.
