1 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the present petition has been filed challenging the order of transfer dated 20.02.2024 (Annexure P-4), but keeping in view the fresh development, as the petitioner is already working on deputation on the post of Transport Inspector at Gurugram, the authorities at RTA Gurugram, have written to the department that the services of the petitioner are needed at Gurugram, the respondents be directed to consider the said request and decide whether, the petitioner is to join at the place of posting where he has been posted as per the impugned order, Annexure P-4, dated 20.02.2024 or he is to be allowed to continue at Gurugram on deputation.

2 Notice of motion.

3 Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4 Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any such request of allowing the petitioner to continue on deputation is received from the competent authority, the same will be decided within a period of seven days from the date of receipt of the same and in case, after the decision, any change to the order of transfer is to be effected, the same will be done.

5 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
