1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to provide all necessary documents to the petitioner pertaining to Case No. 14-A of 18.03.2016 decided on 07.07.2017 by the Court of Tehsildar, Dhar Kalan, which he had demanded by way of an application bearing No. 124 dated 08.11.2021 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for redressal of his grievance the petitioner he has already filed a representation dated 01.02.2022 (Annexure P-4) before the respondents but no action has been taken on the same till date.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that for redressal of his grievance, the petitioner should file a fresh representation before respondent No.2.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner be granted liberty to file a fresh representation before respondent No.2 i.e.

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Deputy Commissioner, District Pathankot, Pathankot and he be directed to decide the same after hearing the petitioner in a time bound manner.

5. After hearing both the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file his appropriate representation before respondent No.2 i.e. Deputy Commissioner, District Pathankot, Pathankot as prayed for with a period of two weeks from today. If any such representation is filed by the petitioner within the stipulated period, then respondent No.2 is directed to hear the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of its filing.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
