1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents for providing the job on compassionate ground to petitioner No.3 and for releasing the full family pension and all benefits as per the share of the petitioners (3/4th) on account of death of Ram Avtar, predecessor of the petitioners.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to approach the competent authority for redressal of the grievance as has been raised in the present writ petition, by serving a justice demand notice.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
4. However, if any, such demand notice is served upon by the petitioners within a period of one month from today, the same shall be considered and disposed of within a period of 03 months thereafter.
