JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of Award dated 01.03.2001 (Annexure P-8) whereby Labour Court has ordered to reinstate the workman with full back wages.
2. Mr. Arvind Seth, Advocate for the petitioners submits that pursuant to impugned order, the workman-respondent No.1 was permitted to join in 2002 and since then he is working with the Management. He is regularly paid salary at D.C. rate.
3. Mr. Kuldeep Sharma, Advocate for respondent No.1 submits that if impugned order is upheld, he would not claim continuity of service i.e. benefit of service from 1996 to 2002 and back wages.
4. To resolve the dispute and keeping in view the fact that



workman is working with Management since 2002, the impugned order is modified to the extent that workman shall not be entitled to back wages as well as continuity of service.
