Keeping in view the fact that the order dated 05.03.2024 has not been complied with, the present application is allowed and the writ petition is revived.

On joint request of learned counsel for the parties, the present writ petition is taken up for consideration.

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the post of Chairman and Members in the Haryana Human Rights Commission have not been filled up, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner as the proceedings which the petitioner has initiated before the Human Rights Commission, are not being taken to the logical end due to the non appointment of the Chairman and Members of the Commission.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that all the efforts were being made to fill the post in question but keeping in view the fact that the General Elections have been announced and Code of Conduct has come in operation, the post could not be filled up despite undertaking to fill the same by 31.03.2024 as the Code of Conduct has come into operation prior to the said date. Hence, appropriate time be given after the Code of Conduct is lifted for filling up the post in question.

3. Keeping in view the facts mentioned by the learned counsel for the respondents, it is directed that within a period of three weeks of the lifting of the Code of Conduct, all the posts be filled up positively.

4. The present writ petition is disposed of in above terms.
