ANIL KSHETARPAL, J

1. In this regular second appeal, the plaintiff assails the correctness of the concurrent findings of fact arrived at by the courts below while dismissing his suit for recovery of Rs.12,500/- which includes Rs.8000/- as principal amount.
2. Both the courts on appreciation of the evidence have found that the accounts of the defendants (respondents) were settled in the year 1976 and the pronote and receipt has been manipulated. It has been found that there are interpolations in the pronote and receipt.
3. Though, the learned counsel representing the appellant made sincere attempt, however, failed to draw any substantive error in the judgments and decrees passed by the courts below.
4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and discussion, no ground to interfere is made out.

5. Dismissed.
6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
