1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 19.10.2023 passed in CWP-23002-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondents has produced copy of order dated 19.04.2024 vide which necessary relief, as per the order of Writ Court, has been granted to the petitioner.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
