Present writ petition has been filed for directing respondent No.2 to decide the partition application dated 26.08.2021 (Annexure P-1) pending in the Court of respondent No.2 in a time bound manner as the same are pending since 2021 and partition has not been effected despite a passage of over 2 ½ years since the institution of the partition proceedings especially in view of Section 111/118-A of the Haryana Land Revenue Act, 1887 whereby the partition proceedings are required to be conducted within a period of six months from the date of partition application.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that inadvertently, respondent No.2 has been mentioned as Assistant Collector, 2nd Grade, Nigdu, District Karnal instead of Assistant Collector 1st Grade Assandh, District Karnal and the same may be corrected as such.

In view of oral request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No.2 i.e. Assistant Collector 2nd Grade, Nigdu, District Karnal be now read as Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Assandh, District Karnal. Registry is directed to carry out the necessary correction in the memo of parties.

Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Upasna Dhawan, AAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2-State. She has submitted that the partition application filed by the petitioner would be decided expeditiously.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. the Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Assandh to take up the partition application and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of three months from today.
