Status report by way of an affidavit of Shri Shamsher Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Faridkot, District Faridkot has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3- State. Para No.3 of the said status report is relevant, which reads as under:

“That the petitioner in her statement has got recorded that her son Sukhchain Singh got married with Parvinder Kaur d/o Massa Singh who are their close neighbours in the same village. After their marriage his son and daughter-in-law did not visit their families or their relatives. The Sarpanch Balwant Singh -respondent no.4 came to her family only to persuade them with the customs of the village where no marriage is performed in the neighbourhood and asked for a solution. But no threat was made by respondent no. 4. The petitioner got recorded that presently she or her family have no complaint nor fear of private respondents and they do not want to pursue her complaint or her present petition. The statement of the petitioner was counter signed by her family persons and various local inhabitants. Copies of statement of petitioner and separate joint statement of Panchayat are annexed herewith as Annexure: R-1/T and R-2/T respectively.”

The status report is accompanied by statement of petitioner Gurpreet Kaur as Annexure R-1/T besides the copy of Panchayatnama as Annexure R-2/T.

In view of the aforesaid report accompanied by Panchayatnama, no further direction is required to be issued.
