SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. By way of present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, seeking quashing of the order dated 17.09.1998, Annexure P4, passed by respondent No.2 as well as order dated 28.11.1997 passed by respondent No.3.

2. Mr.Narwal submits that the filing counsel had sent registered communications to the petitioner, however, there is no response from him.

3. While admitting this writ petition, no interim order was passed. Probably the disputed amount of stamp duty must have been deposited. As petitioner is not coming forward to pursue the writ

petition, it is dismissed for non-prosecution.

4. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to seek revival
in case anything worthwhile survives for consideration.
