1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to extend the services of the petitioner upto the age of 60 years according to the policy decision dated 19.11.2014 (Annexure P-2) issued by the Government of Punjab and the circular dated 24.07.2015 (Annexure P-3) issued by the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited as the petitioner falls within the category of disabled employee.
2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 04.03.2024, the following order was passed :-

“Mr. Ashish Nagar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner and filed power of attorney, which is taken on record. He seeks time to get instructions in the matter.

Learned counsel for the respondents has placed on record the speaking order dated 19.05.2023, whereby the

claim of the petitioner for extension in service has been rejected.

Adjourned to 06.03.2024.

To be taken up after the urgent cases.”

3. Since the claim of the petitioner has already been considered and rejected by the respondents vide speaking order dated 19.05.2023, the present petition is disposed of with the liberty to the petitioner to challenge the speaking order dated 19.05.2023, if so advised.
