1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to promote the petitioner as Deputy Superintendent of Police, Telecommunication, Haryana.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the present matter pertains to year 1998 and the present petition, in all probability, has been rendered infructuous.
3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect.
4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed for non-prosecution at this stage. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present case, in case, any cause of action survives in the same.
