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**SANJAY VASHISTH, J.(Oral)**

1. Present writ petition has been filed by workman-Gurmail Singh, assailing the award dated 15.05.1997 passed by Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Bathinda, whereby reference No.30/1995 under Section 10 (1) (C) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 has been partly held against him.

2. The findings given by learned Tribunal is that termination of the workman by the Management though was justified, but it was not in order thus, only the compensation amount of Rs.3277/- was ordered to be paid to the workman.

3. Perusal of the paper-book reveals that the present writ petition is pending since the year 1998 (for the last about 26 years). There is no representation on behalf of the parties. This Court is left

with no other option, except to dismiss the petition, same being not prosecuted.

4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
5. However, petitioner will be at liberty to move an application for revival of the present writ petition within eight weeks from today, in case any substantial issue warranting its decision, still survives.
