The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents to make the payment of the compensation to the petitioner for acquisition of his land, in accordance with the Award dated 01.05.1992 of DRO/Land Acquisition Collector (Military Cantonment), Hisar.
2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, despite the fact that in the previous order, it was specifically recorded that no further adjournment shall be granted. The order-sheets of the case also show that the petitioner has continuously remained absent from the proceedings.
3. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further with the present writ petition.
