1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No. 81 dated 17.06.2015 under Section 354 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, Tehsil Anandpur Sahib, District Ropar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as the FIR in question, on the basis of compromise dated 07.11.2022, has already been quashed by the Coordinate Bench vide order dated 18.12.2023 in CRM-M-52613-2022, Ishwar Dass Vs. State of Punjab and another. He has produced the copy of the said order, which is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition.
