The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India against the order dated 04.09.2018 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Additional District Judge, Chandigarh in Rent Appeal No.74/2018 vide which the lower Court has granted mesne profits to the extent of Rs.30,000/- per month.
