HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (Oral)

1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that the petitioners who are working as a Casualty Medical Officers on regular basis are entitled for the same pay-scale as being extended to the other medical officers who are working in the Government of Haryana.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that once the job profile as well as the qualification for appointment to both the posts are identical, giving two different pay-scales to the Doctors working as a Casualty Medical Officers or the Medical Officers, cannot be different.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.6 submits that the claim of the petitioners as raised by them in the present petition, was raised before the authorities concerned and the same has

already been recommended for consideration of the University and as and when the Government decides the said issue, in case any relief is to be granted to the petitioners, the same will be extended to them.

4. Learned State counsel submits that in case, the issue with regard to the grant of same pay-scale to the Casualty Medical Officers as given to the Medical Officers, as recommended by respondent No.6, is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, appropriate decision will be taken within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order and the final decision taken by the Government, will be informed to respondent No.6 accordingly.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.
