1. On 20.04.2024, a Coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased
to pass the following order:-

*“Learned counsel appearing for the appellant, and
learned counsel appearing for the respondent submit
that they have no instructions from their respective
parties in the instant matter.*

*Let court notice be also issued to the appellant,
and the respondent, returnable on 04.07.2024.*
