1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.2 & 3 to decide the representation dated 08.05.2023 (Annexure P-1).
2. At the outset, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG Punjab submits that after the representation dated 08.05.2023 (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioner to SHO, Sadar, P.S. Bahawala, the matter was duly enquired into and finding the same to be false, the aforesaid representation was consigned to the record room on 20.12.2023.
3. However, this is a fit case, where the cost is to be imposed upon the petitioner, as he has not approached this Court with clean hands, but this Court would refrain from passing any such order, wherein ignorance may also be one of the reason for which the petitioner has not been informed by the police authorities about the said consignment of the representation to the record room.
4. Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG Punjab undertakes that the necessary order passed on consideration of that representation will be communicated to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.
5. The petition stands disposed off.
