1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of regulations (Annexure P-1) governing promotions of employees. The petitioners are further seeking setting aside of order dated 02.02.1996 (Annexure P-7) whereby appeals of the petitioners assailing promotion of private respondents have been dismissed.
2. The petitioners are assailing promotion of private respondents and regulations (Annexure P-1) which are governing promotion of employees from MMGS-III to SMGS-IV. These regulations have been made by respondent-State Bank of Patiala (now known as State Bank of India).
3. The writ petition was filed in 1997 and there was no stay in favour of the petitioners. The matter was listed before this Bench on

16.12.2023 and there was no representation on behalf of the parties. The Registry was directed to send communication to the petitioners.

4. As per office report, counsel for the petitioners has been duly intimated and letter sent to petitioner No.1 has been received back undelivered.

5. Despite being called twice today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners as well as respondents. It appears that with the efflux of time, the parties have lost their interest to pursue the matter.

6. Dismissed for want of prosecution.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
