1. Application for condonation of delay of 148 days in filing the appeal is allowed, in view of averments made in the application duly supported by affidavit of the appellant.

2. Delay condoned.

3. CM stands disposed of.

4. The present appeal is directed against the order dated 28.08.2023 passed by the learned Single Judge in CWP-17126-2023, Baljit Kaur vs. State of Punjab and others. The learned Single Judge has declined to interfere in the order of transfer dated 25.07.2023 of the appellant from Mansa to Malerkotla, which is at a distance of 100 kilometers.

5. A perusal of the abovesaid order dated 25.07.2023 would go on to show that it was on account of litigation as such that the order was passed and transfer took place *inter se* one with Hakam Singh, who was sent from Malerkotla to Mansa.

6. In such circumstances, due to administrative exigencies, transfer has been done without any *mala fide*. Accordingly, we do not find any tangible reason to interfere in the order of the learned Single Judge and the present appeal stands dismissed. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of accordingly.
