KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuing a *mandamus* upon the official respondents to register an FIR against respondents no.6 to 9, under various provisions of law for committing fraud and forgery with the present petitioner.

2. A perusal of the instant petition reflects that, in fact the instant petition is a misconceived motion, inasmuch as, despite the petitioner being seized of an alternate and efficacious statutory remedy for redressal of his grievance, yet he has sidetracked the said remedy and have straightway accessed this Court, through instituting the present petition.

Faced with the above difficulty, learned senior counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the instant petition, however, with liberty reserved to the petitioner to recourse with an alternative available statutory remedy(ies) before the appropriate authority/forum concerned, for redressal of his grievance.
4. **Dismissed as withdrawn** with the aforesaid liberty.
