HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that while appearing in the written examination for CET Group C posts against the Advertisement No.3/2023 dated 07.03.2023 (Annexure P-1), the petitioner faced certain difficulties attributable to the respondent-Commission. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the question booklet and OMR sheet which was given to the petitioner carried a different name and even in the attendance sheet, name of some other candidate was mentioned instead of the petitioner and it took some time to resolve the said issue but the petitioner was not given extra time in finishing her written examination, which fact has caused prejudice to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance raised in the present writ petition has already been raised by the

petitioner in the representation dated 20.02.2024 (Annexure P-6) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation dated 20.02.2024 (Annexure P-6) has been received in the concerned office and is still pending consideration, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of ten days of the receipt of copy of this order.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
