MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although it had been stated by the learned State counsel on the previous date of hearing that there was no threat perception qua the life and liberty of the petitioner, however subsequently, the son of the petitioner had been attacked by the private respondents, in which regard a complaint had also been given to the official respondents.

3. In the circumstances, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to look afresh into the threat perception qua the petitioner and his family members, and take appropriate steps at the earliest in accordance with law.
