1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking setting aside of order dated 03.11.2023 (Annexure P-6) passed by the learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab, whereby the revision petition filed by the petitioner against final order of Partition dated 23.07.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Assistant Collector, Grade-1, Dasuya, has been dismissed.

1.1 A further prayer has been made to set aside final order of Partition dated 23.07.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Assistant Collector, Grade-1, Dasuya.

2. A perusal of order sheets would reveal that on 20.03.2024, learned counsel for the petitioner had sought for an accommodation to place on record copy of the site plan. Thereafter, the matter had been adjourned on

three occasions, i.e. 16.04.2024, 13.05.2024 and 03.07.2024, at the request of learned counsel for the petitioner.

2.1 On the last date of hearing (03.07.2024), learned counsel for the petitioner had sought time to comply with order dated 20.03.2024, however today, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner nor order dated 20.03.2024 has been complied with, till date. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant matter any further.

3. Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.

4. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
