VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, mandamus or any other suitable writ, order or direction to quash the order dated 01.06.1995 (Annexure P-13) vide which respondent No. 1 has decided that the period of suspension from 01.06.1987 to 18.10.1988 be treated as extra ordinary leave.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter is of the year 1997 and he is not in touch with his client and thus, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage but liberty be granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to him.
3. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty aforesaid.
