1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.170 dated 24.11.2023, registered under Sections 452, 380, 427, 506 IPC, at Police Station Sirhali, District Tarn Taran.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of order dated 29.02.2024, the petitioner has already deposited a sum of Rs.10,000/- before the Illaqa Magistrate.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from police official submits that in compliance of orders dated 11.03.2024 and 29.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation.

4. Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petition is allowed. Order dated 29.02.2024 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the

investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
