1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.2 & 3 to conduct fair and impartial inquiry in the complaint/representation dated 17.02.2024 (Annexure P-6).
2. Having perused the instant petition, the assertions raised in the instant petition do not warrant any interference at this stage by this Court, wherein a representation/complaint dated 17.02.2024 made to the DGP, Punjab is still pending.
3. Without waiting of the outcome of said complaint, the petitioner has acted in haste by invoking the jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C., which is though an inherent power, but also needs to be exercised with caution and abundant care not in a matter of routine in such like cases, as has been pleaded in the instant petition.
4. However, in the interest of justice, this Court directs Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG Punjab to ensure that the complaint/representation dated 17.02.2024 addressed to DGP, Punjab be considered and decided by passing a speaking order

within a period of four weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order. A copy of order so passed by supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

5. In view of the above, present petition stands disposed off.
