1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for the quashing of impugned order No.10927-28/PB dated 04.06.2022.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has given an application dated 12.01.2024 (Annexure P-10), but a copy of the order No.10927-28/PB dated 04.06.2022, as mentioned in the reply dated 14.06.2023 (Annexure P-6) to the legal notice, has not been supplied to the petitioner till date. It is further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.4 is directed to supply a copy of the said order No.10927-28/PB dated 04.06.2022, within a specified time frame.
3. A perusal of the impugned order (Annexure P-6) would show that while rejecting the claim of the petitioner in the legal notice given by

him, the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Headquarters, Gurugram had stated that the services of the petitioner were dismissed vide order No.10927-28/PB dated 04.06.2022 . It is the case of the petitioner that he had not been supplied a copy of the said order in spite of application dated 12.01.2024 (Annexure P-10).

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances and a limited prayer made by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with the following directions: -

- (i) Petitioner would go to the office of respondent No.4 on 05.03.2024 at 11.00 AM and would deposit the necessary fee for the supply of the copy of the order No.10927-28/PB dated 04.06.2022.
- (ii) On doing so, office of respondent No.4 would supply a copy of the said order No.10927-28/PB dated 04.06.2022 on the same date or within a period of one week thereafter.
- (iii) Upon getting a copy of the order No.10927-28/PB dated 04.06.2022, it would be open to the petitioner to lay challenge to the same in accordance with law.
