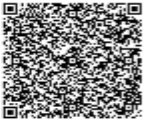

RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order/communication dated 11.05.2023 (Annexure P-5), dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-6) and the undertaking and statement dated 17.10.2022 (Annexure P-3) made before Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Ferozepur and the award dated 12.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by the National Lok Adalat, Ferozepur.

2. Short reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.1 filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.

3. Counsel for respondent No.1 submits that the the orders/award qua which the contempt is asserted, have since been complied with and needful has been done. Therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.



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4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
