The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.207 dated 22.08.2023 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 353, 186, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 27.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 02.04.2024 by way of an affidavit of Jatin Bansal, PPS, ACP, Civil Lines, Ludhiana, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. She on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 27.02.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
