1. This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to the official respondents for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 7 and 8.

2. Heard.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that feeling aggrieved by the acts and conduct of the private respondents, the petitioner has moved a representation dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-6) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, but no action has been taken thereon.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police,

Fatehgarh Sahib, to dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

- 5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.
- 6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.
- 7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-6), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.
- 8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
- 9. Disposed of.
