JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to allow him to join duty and release consequential benefits.

2. Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that petitioner was a part of Punjab Home Guards and he has already attained the age of superannuation. He was not holding a permanent or regular post, thus, in such circumstances, there is no question of permitting him to rejoin.

3. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent may be directed to release dues of the petitioner which accrued to him on account of service rendered by him during 1991 to 1998.

4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent to calculate dues of the
