JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (ORAL)

1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned order dated 19.07.2022 (Annexure P-8).
2. On 27.02.2024, when it was pointed out to the learned counsel for the petitioner that the impugned order (Annexure P-8) is not complete and the relevant pages are missing from the same, he prayed for some time to place on record the complete typed copy of the impugned order (Annexure P-8).
3. On 29.02.2024, an application was moved by the petitioner for placing on record the said order so that at least the complete impugned order can be perused by this Court.

4. A perusal of the typed copy of the impugned order (Annexure P-8) reveals that again the same mistake has been committed and the missing pages of the impugned order are still not attached and the order attached with the application is exactly the same as that of the previous order, which is attached with the main petition.
5. Mr. Samarth Saggar, learned Addl. A.G., Haryana also stated that the aforesaid order is not the complete impugned order.
6. This Court is of the view that even after granting an opportunity to the petitioner, the complete impugned order has not been placed on record. Therefore, this Court is not able to peruse the entire impugned order and cannot interfere in the present petition.
7. Consequently, the present petition is hereby dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition along with complete impugned order (Annexure P-8) in accordance with law.
