1. On 27.05.2024, this Court was pleased to pass the following
order:-

*“Present: Ms. Armaan Saggar, Advocate
for the appellant.*

*Learned counsel for the appellant has
submitted that inspite of the best efforts, she has not been able
to get in touch with the appellant and prays that the notice be
issued to the appellant as well as to the respondent.*

*Let actual date notice be issued to the appellant
as well as to the respondent for 17.10.2024.”*

2. As per the report of the registry, sole appellant as well as sole
respondent have died.

3. Learned Senior counsel for the appellant has submitted that no one
on behalf of the appellant has contacted his office and in spite of the best efforts,
he has not been able to get in touch with the LR's of the appellant and thus,
he is not in a position to state as to whether any cause survives in the present

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appeal as on date and hence, he prays that the present appeal may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty may be granted to the LRs of the appellant to revive the appeal, in case any cause of action survives.
