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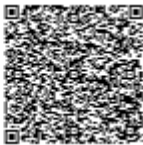
**NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to pay the petitioner regular pay scale as admissible to Art & Craft Teacher in the Department of Education, Punjab, instead of consolidated salary.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 13.08.2024, the following order was passed :-

*“Learned State counsel has produced a copy of order dated 27.01.2003 issued by the Additional Deputy Commissioner (Development), Jalandhar, whereby the services of the petitioner have been terminated w.e.f. 01.10.2000. Copy of the said order has been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner, who seeks time to get instructions.*

*Adjourned to 11.09.2024.”*



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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the fact that the services of the petitioner have been terminated w.e.f. 01.10.2000, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
