1. Through the instant petition, under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer is made for issuance of directions to respondent No.1 and 2, to conduct a fair and impartial inquiry, at the earliest into the complaint moved by the petitioner on 18.09.2023 (Annexure P-5), for registration of FIR against respondents No.5, 6 and others, including revenue officials/staff of respondents No.3 and 4.
2. Without availing the alternate remedy, as available to the petitioner under the Cr.P.C., the petitioner has straightaway filed the instant motion, which under the opinion of this Court is a premature motion, therefore, the instant petition is dismissed, however, with liberty to avail alternate remedy(ies), as available to the petitioner in accordance with law.
