By way of present petition, challenge is made to order dated 22.12.2021, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda, charge-sheeting the petitioners in a case FIR No.73 dated 19.05.2021 registered under Sections 307, 379-B, 324, 325, 326, 323, 34, IPC at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

Along with the petition, application bearing CRM No.9897 of 2024 is moved under Section 5 of the Limitation Act to condone the delay of 741 days in filing this revision. It is submitted that earlier the petitioner had approached this Court by filing CRR No.595 of 2022, which was dismissed as withdrawn on 29.04.2022 to raise all the points before the trial Court. However, no evidence has been recorded before the trial Court till date so as to substantiate the charges.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any plausible reason to condone the delay of 741 days in filing this revision against the impugned order and so, the application is hereby dismissed.

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Since the application for condonation of delay of 741 day is dismissed, therefore, main petition also stands dismissed being barred by limitation.
