1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 22.12.2023 passed in CWP-28853-2023.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of the respondent, filed in the Registry, is taken on record. Costs of Rs.10,000/-, as imposed upon the respondent vide order dated 29.04.2024, have also been deposited vide receipt dated 11.07.2024.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 22.12.2023 passed in CWP-28853-2023 has since been complied with and representation of the petitioner has been decided by passing the speaking order dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure R-1).
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, it would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
