1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing Credit Information Bureau (India) Limited ('CIBIL') Reports dated 03.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) and 02.03.2021 (Annexure P-8).

2. Grievance raised by petitioner in the writ petition is that there was no liability of petitioner towards respondent - Banks therefore, necessary correct information should have been uploaded on the website of CIBIL.

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that requisite and correct information has been uploaded after verification from respondent – Banks therefore, this writ petition is rendered infructuous.
