The present application has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing the Registry to release the draft No.021307 dated 27.03.2019 of an amount of Rs.1 lakh deposited in view of the order dated 19.03.2019.

Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner *inter alia* contends that the parties to the *lis* has compromised vide compromise deed dated 04.08.2020 and thereafter, this Court was approached by way of filing of CRM-M-26458-2020 for seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise and on 14.09.2020, the FIR in question was quashed. The statement of both the parties was recorded in a petition filed under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act and the petitioner has paid all the three instalments to the complainant/respondent No.2 in terms of the compromise and she has already received full and final settlement amount towards her past present and future alimony, as such, the amount of Rs.1 lakh lying deposited with the Registry of

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this Court in terms of order dated 19.03.2019 passed by this Court, is required to be returned to the petitioner in view of the full and final settlement between the parties.

CRM stands allowed.

Registry is directed to return the draft bearing No.021307 dated 27.03.2019 amounting to Rupees One Lakh to the petitioner against proper identification and receipt, as per rules.

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.07 dated 23.01.2018 under Section 498 -A of IPC registered at Police Station Women, Gurgaon, District Gurugram (Annexure P-5) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as withdrawn as having been rendered infructuous.
