1. This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.8 dated 26.11.2021 (Annexure P-2) lodged under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station NRI, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar along with all consequential proceedings qua petitioners.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in the present case, respondent No.5, who is an ex-MLA, is neither an accused nor the complainant and thus, he is not a necessary party in the petition. It is further submitted that the petitioners be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after deleting respondent No.5 from the array of parties and after specifically challenging the order framing of charge and also after annexing the report under under Section 173 Cr.P.C.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
