1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the arrears of amount of Rs.2,52,424/- as arrears of revised gratuity, leave encashment, P.F. and salary etc.

2. Reply on behalf of respondent No.3-the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Raman, District Bathinda, has been filed in the Court which is taken on record. In the said reply, it has been stated that after filing of the present petition, the amount claimed in the writ petition i.e. Rs.2,52,424/- has been released to the petitioner, vide letter dated 31.05.2023 (Annexure R-3/1) and, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
